


Rashtriya Ekta Divas – 31st October, 2018

Lalitha V and Radhashree made a Power Point presentation with special emphasis on the life of Sardar Patel and his commitment to National integration.





To instil the values professed by Sardar Patel, a pledge was taken by the students of Springdays, reminding us of the unification of our nation- India.
