Breath Taking Infrastructure

Ensconced in the pristine splendour of 8 acres of verdant woods and occupying 150000 sq.ft., Springdays is a living testimony to the nascent concept of 'Green Buildings'. The architecture of the school is one of a kind, that is inspired from prestigious institutions worldwide and is an inspiration to many.

Springdays is one of the first schools to follow the National Building Code of India (NBC) Guidelines for schools.

Architected for the hot summers of Vellore

Every part of the school has a natural vent for hot air thus keeping the rooms cool even during hot summers. The architecture accommodates free flow of wind and breeze thus accommodating the climate patterns of Vellore. High ceilings further add to the airiness of the classrooms.

Roof gardens on all terraces brings down the temperature of the classrooms substantially during the long summers. Doubly-shaded corridors with well-placed benches form cool and comfortable interaction spaces for the children. Three integrated green courtyards with enough shade from overhanging buildings and greenery provide ample play areas for children. A well planned-out landscape with varied flora, water fountains, well-supplied seating and discreet play areas attract birds and butterflies creating a beautiful environment for growth and joy. True to its name, Springdays keep its children in an 'Eternal Spring'.

Front Facade Elevation

The front facade of the Administrative Office building of the school is inspired from Colonial style architecture but also carries through the colours and aesthetics of the Springdays logo. Tall pillars and high ceilings stand as tall as its founder, T.Rajendiran's passion towards building a world-class institute.

Specially architected classrooms

Spacious classrooms, each resting on 850 sq.ft. of floor space, with airy ventilation and thorough natural lighting has been designed to create the right ambiance for research and study. The building expands tree-like with overhanging classrooms and large green areas for out-door, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. All classrooms have specially designed furniture, appropriate to the height of the child, that aid good posture. All classrooms have plenty of space for curriculum activities to be conducted alongside classroom teaching.

Five gallery-style classrooms, with audio-visual and acoustic facilities are designed to accommodate special lectures for senior secondary children.







Multi-purpose Auditorium & Atrium

An indoor, multi-purpose auditorium, with 2000 seats along three separate courtyards serves as spaces to conduct lectures and workshops. Another well-shaded, gallery-style Atrium, that houses 800 children serves a space for common assembly of children during school hours.

Music Room

A beautifully and acoustically designed Music Room is situated at the centre of the school. The music room itself occupies an area of 1200 sq.ft.

Well - equipped Labs

Six state-of-the-art laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology, Social Studies and Lego & Robotics, and special ICT (Information and Communications Technology) labs are at the disposal of the students for practical research. Each lab can accommodate a minimum of 40 children at a time. The labs are provided with the latest equipments and upgraded periodically to help the children have an enriching experience. These labs, with accessible safety exits are provided with ample lighting and ventilation on either side.

Universally accessible Design

All floors and all spaces of the school have incorporated ramps thus making the whole school universally accessible. Additionally, the school also has 8 staircases and lifts.

Cafeteria and Dining space

A 4000 sq.ft., of canteen space can serve up to 250 children at a time. The canteen kitchen, which occupies another 700 sq.ft., is well-equipped to provide the children with healthy and hygienic food. Handwash areas of 550 sq.ft. with sinks at varying heights aids children of all ages to use them.





Medical care

The school has a well-equipped infirmary with an on-duty nurse and separate toilet facility. The infirmary is well-supplied with first aid and primary medical care equipment and medications to attend to minor ailments in children.

School Library - The Learning Commons

The Springdays Library, called as 'Learning Commons', occupies 2900 sq.ft., and is a common area that shares space for information technology, remote or online education, tutoring, collaboration, content creation, meetings and reading. This is a next-generation library where information can be accessed not only from books, but also from online resources, peers, collaborative work etc. The school also has a massive collection of books with new additions of classics, reference books, journals and bestsellers. We aim to match the highest library standards of the country.

Staff Rooms

10 corporate-quality staff rooms with attached pantry facilities and toilet facilities, are positioned amidst classrooms for easy access of children.

Playing fields and Outdoor sports facility

A vast play area with provisions for cricket, basketball, volleyball, and football fields, tennis courts and 200 meters running track is provided which matches international standards.

Springdays Curriculum

Our curriculum forms the backbone of Springdays. Springdays has a distinguished curriculum team that is responsible for constantly refining and upgrading the education imparted at every stage of education. This team reports directly to the management.

Affiliation

Springdays follows the globally accepted and most sought after CBSE curriculum. The CBSE board provides a well-standardized syllabus and framework for the children to thrive and flourish in.

Medium of Instruction

English is the medium of instruction.

Tamil, Hindi and French are offered as second languages at Primary and Secondary school level.



Kindergarten Curriculum (PreKG, LKG & UKG)

Springdays Kindergarten Education is stress-free for the child and parents. We provide a holistic and balanced curriculum that engages and develops all senses of a child - Dance & Movement, Singing, Cooking, Leadership Skills, Drawing, Communication, Etiquette, Story Telling, Book Reading, etc.

Our curriculum is completely activity based that caters to each child's personalised learning. Our activities are inspired from the best of Waldorf Steiner's Methodology, Montessori and others. However, Howard Gardner's 'Multiple Intelligence Learning' methodology underpins our curriculum that structures the personalised learning that we offer to each child. 'Multiple Intelligence Learning' methodology ensures that the child's freedom of thought, inquisitiveness and desire for learning is kept alive. It suggests that every child has seven types of intelligences with varying affinity to each of them. They are logical, verbal, musical, spatial, kinesthetics, interpersonal and intra-personal intelligences. A child thinks, learns and applies better when the teaching method aligns with the intelligence that he is strong in.

For many children, Springdays will be their first formal socializing experience with the outside world. With that in mind, the curriculum imparted at this stage is made hospitable, enjoyable and yet coherently challenging. With adjoining gardens, play areas and attached toilets, the little children can enjoy the learning process in safe and secure spaces.

On completion of 2 years of age by June 1st of the year of admission, children can be admitted to PreKG. On completion of 3 years of age by June 1st of the year of admission, children can be admitted to LKG and likewise.

Primary School Curriculum (Grade I to V)

Springdays believes in giving children varied exposure at a very young age to broaden their curiosity and love for learning. The school has a balanced and well-proven primary school curriculum. It has wide-range of classroom programs that ensures a well-rounded development of the child. There is no homework till grade 2.

As a natural transition to primary schooling, our curriculum adapts into an investigative and inquiry-based learning programme and sustains the child's interest in learning. When subjects like mathematics, sciences and social studies are taught using this methodology, it gives the child a solid foundation to build on.

Languages and sciences are also integrated with the Lego & Robotics Innovation Program and gives the child a hands-on learning experience. Children learn to code from Grade 3 as part of this program. As part of the digital & Al driven world, understanding digital languages will form the building blocks of how our children understand the workings of the future world.

Our Lego & Robotics Lab and Creative Arts Labs completes the STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Maths) Education for the child. We believe that a STEAM education will make our children proficient in the technology assisted world of the future.

Springdays has a unique Leadership Curriculum to impart EQ skills to children such as Emotional Intelligence, Empathy, Growth Mindset, Self-esteem etc. The curriculum is non-spiritual, simple and delivered through experiential activities in the classroom. Singing and Dancing (Zumba) is compulsory for all primary students with one period per week dedicated for each. Zumba also fills the gap in the required daily dose of physical activity for children apart from being a performing art.

We have special Language Development Program that helps developing children's communication (writing and oratory) skills. An elaborate book reading program helps children develop interest in the world of books.

From Grade 3 onwards, children experience specially curated Virtual Reality content to arouse their curiosity on science and social science learning topics. The concepts have better reception in children after the Virtual Reality based immersive experience.

From Grade 4 onwards, Design Thinking is introduced to children to help them experiment & empathise in their Lego & Robotics Program. We believe that a design mindset is needed for children to be able to accommodate different perspectives and build products\services in their future careers.

Our Inter-house activities, is a platform to identify and develop talents in children. All children are exposed to going up on stage and presenting their talent. This goes a long way in building the child's self-esteem, leadership and leadership skills. IHA topics are varied and well curated with a global perspective.

Apart from co-curricular activities, we also offer optional plethora of extracurricular activities for children to further develop their talent in specific areas.

Secondary School Curriculum (Grade VI to X)

As part of the secondary curriculum, we strike the right balance between curricular and cocurricular activities. Secondary schooling is an important stage in a child's development when the child's seamless energy must be channelled into productive areas of development. Apart from the co-curricular activities covered as part of the Primary Curriculum, children are exposed to more independent co-curricular activities like Theatre Training, Nutrition Squad and Voice of Springdays.

Communication & Etiquette Through Art & Craft (Kindergarten)

We have a separate curriculum for inculcating etiquette and good manners in children. This will be done alongside normal school hours and lunch or snack break by a special CETAC teacher together with the class teacher.

D for Dance Program (Kindergarten)

Our Kindergarten curriculum has a well-integrated dance and movement program. Every lesson plan has an age-appropriate movement/dance session to make sure that children are in par with physical health. This not only enables kinesthetic learners but also improves motor development, co-ordination, balance, physical fitness, flexibility and body awareness in children. Most importantly, it fights child obesity that is becoming an epidemic world-wide. This program is highly blended with the curriculum topics in such a way that it reinforces the child's learning. It also acts as a boost to the child's creative expressions and self-esteem. D for Dance classes are conducted by a Dance and Movement expert from the field.

Voice of Springdays (Std VI onwards)

Voice of Springdays, a student-centred activity club which covers school news, sports events, festivals, celebrations, Jamboree - a special cultural annual event of the school and much more.
